

**GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES
JULY 5, 2016**

Butch Reyburn called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

In attendance were Butch Reyburn, Brandon Haynes [IGM], Brad Rook [IGM], Pat Bradshaw, Don Chapman, Scott McKettrick, Edward Simpkins, Duane Gore, Diane Griffin, Lee Kapka & Theresa Taylor.

The minutes were approved after correction was made to the June minutes.

Under Brandon Haynes report referring to effluent water, “ We must take **7,200** gal. a day” should have been “We must take **72,000** gal. a day”

REPORTS:

GOLF SUPERINTENDENT, BRANDON HAYNES / IGM

June recorded 0.00 of rain. Temperatures ranged from 60’s to the upper 90’s. The greens are being mowed 6 times per week. They are staying healthy. Fairways are being mowed at least twice a week. Roughs are mowed twice a week and reseeding is continuing in the bare areas. The wells that pump water into Four Island Lake are not functioning due to “Dirty Power” from Edison, which is a power fluctuation that causes the pumps to shut down. Mr. Simpkins has discussed this with Mr. Zanutto, who is pushing SCE to place this problem on their priority list.

With the recent fires during the 4th of July weekend, fire agencies have been using Jacks Pond as a “dip tank” for water to fight the Deer Fire. As a result, plans to pump water from Jack’s Pond to Four Island Lake have been placed on hold, pending a reevaluation of it’s volume.

Repair of exit area on #6 bridge-----complete

Ninety degree rule-----implemented

OLD BUSINESS:

Don Chapman asked if there were funds to replace the golf balls on the driving range. Duane stated that there is funding for adding balls but not total replacement. The balls are roughed up due to the condition of the driving range.

Theresa Taylor asked what the rules were regarding the handicap flags on the golf carts. Duane stated it is uncomfortable to decide who needs the flags and who doesn't. Some of the older players need to be close to the greens.

Sandy Williams sent a request that cross ventilation in the form of either small windows or vented fans be placed in the bathrooms on the 4th hole. Mr. Simpkins said he would have Mark Gonzales look into this.

Scott McKettrick presented his suggested plans for the black tee placement. This information/suggestion will be held for consideration if and when a redesign of the course is completed.

Motion was made to adjourn at 9:25.
