BVS SPORTS ●(MB)

- A. Basketball sign-ups go until August 12th. Evaluations August 17th. Practice starts August 29th, and league starts September 18th. Currently we have 21 sign-ups.

- C. Girls softball camp was canceled due to lack of registration.
- D. Fall-ball (baseball) has been introduced to date there are only 4 registrations in the 10 & under and 3 registrations in the 14 & under. KC suggested to have Sign Up Info in the E Buzz, on BVS Sports Facebook & notices at pool for more families to see signup info. Has a second "Info Sign" like at the gate and Whiting center ever been considered for the corner of Cumberland and Lower Valley Road (by the Water wise garden) for a location for folks that travel Cumberland and not Bear Valley Road.
- E. T-Ball has started. Three teams totaling 31 kids.
- F. Issues with sprinklers on the baseball field have been solve grass is starting to green up.
- G. The batting cage net is in disrepair and not up for replacement till approx. 2020. I've received approval to get quotes to replace the net. I am waiting on a written quote. Prices are \$700 to \$1200 depending on grade of the net.
- H. The water supply back flow device located in the 3rd bas dug-out of the Grizzly Field has been leaking for almost a month. There is a small mud puddle in the dug-out making it a source of interest for the little ball players. Maintenance has been notified. Repairs will require a certified back flow tester. No word on a date for repair.
