Whiting Center

- **New hires to replace Colin & Devan. Matt has been interviewing and one new position has been filled.**
- **Bingo for adults coordinated by the Veterans starts May 14th and will be ongoing on the 2nd Saturday of each month.**
- **Update on Bathroom tile / Remodel project. The plans are at county for approval before they get sent out to bid.**
- **Lobby floor – a test patch was done of the floor stain and it was not well liked.**

- The new bathroom will be delivered just before Memorial Day weekend. The site is being prepared now. Padding has been completed.
- Gary reports padding at back of backstop needs to be repaired. Matt Bryant states he has this on his list to complete.

Campgrounds, Range, & Lakes

- Press conference at the lake today – tree devastation.
- Fire prevention district plans to provide community education for fire prevention.
- Fishing Derby is scheduled for May 21st. – stocking of big catfish planned for just prior.
- Rummage Sale Saturday, May 7th. It will be rescheduled in 2 weeks if weather is bad.
- Jim Carmichael reports 15 acres of deep grass at the shooting range has been cut. Thank-you!
- Jim requests 2 bags of cement to address the gopher holes. Debbie recommended he email both Debbie and Mark (maintenance) to address this.
- Fire breaks were discussed. Debbie says this is a CSD issue.
- Jim reports dogs off leash continues to be an issue at Cub lake. Jim continues to educate offenders and provide a written warning. The committee discussed BVSA authority to cite and fine offenders. Police can be called, but they do not always respond due to other priorities.

Sports Updates

- Soccer is in third week. Foul weather each weekend, but the season is still going well. Kids are having fun.
- Volley ball camp will be offered again this year on June 13-17. Matt will be looking for assistance. Whiting Center staff will hopefully be available to assist again this year.
- Baseball camp: Sign ups start June 1st. Two camps planned.
 - July 11th 7-8 year old camp. Will be capped at 40 kids.
 - July 18th 9-14 year old camp. Will also be capped at 40 kids.
- Matt plans to order a few replacements bases for the ballfields.

Pool

- THS swim team has been practicing here weekdays until the 13th. Championships this week. They are having a great season.
- Lifeguard certification classes were offered by our swim coach.
- New pool supervisor is Katie Neufeld.
- The lifeguards are in the hiring process
- Pool set up and orientation is May 21st
- Replaster the baby pool. Debbie is obtaining bids Hopeful to be open for Memorial Day. Weather could delay this.
- New fencing around the baby pool
- Pool closure – 2 or 3 days week of the 16th.
- Junior lifeguards are planned for this summer.
- BVSA Grizzlies swim team competition begins Memorial Day weekend.

NUMBERS FOR APRIL:

- Number of daily swims for BVS Aquatics :525 participants (17.5 per day)
- Number of Grizzly Swim Team : 269 = 19 kids per day
- Number of participants Tehachapi High School Swim Team :467 = 38 swimmers per day
- Life guard class :41 attending
- *That's a total of 1,302 swims in April-we just exceeded our March total!!!

ITEMS NEEDED:

- Deck has been repaired & Looks good!!!

- **BUT-one more area needs a patch: About 10 feet to the right of the plug where the Johnny Vac sets (between the kitchen wall corner and the pool corner)**
- **Last year we requested a curtain to be installed at the entrance to the Locker rooms and we never got it. Now that all the benches are along the wall we really need it for some privacy.**
- **Still need a winterized gate lock**
- **REQUEST: Locker payments will be collected during May/June \$5 month for 3 summer months=\$15**
- **Lifeguard don't have to pay. Can we exclude some of the pool volunteers from paying i.e. Randy Whitehead & Tuff, Sara Ritchie & children, The Clow's. The committee voted to waive the locker fee for the specific volunteers listed above. They will need to register with the lifeguards or Kimberly Clow.**
