REPORTS:

GOLF SUPERINTENDENT, BRANDON HAYNES/IGM

There was a total of ¾" rainfall this month. Daytime temps were as high as the mid 80's and nighttime lows were in the 30's.

We have begun to use the effluent water on the roughs & perimeters. Brad Rook is helping repair/replace some of the broken sprinkler heads. With our lakes full we should have enough water to last the season.

IGM is fully staffed now with summer workers. Brandon informed the Committee that amenities other than the golf course have and will continue to pull workers away from the course. One project is the Range, which will take approximately one week to clean up.
